

# Looking your personal best

## Year 7 to 11 – Girls

All students should **arrive to school in full school uniform** and only wear sports kit when participating in sport or other outdoor activities that require it. School uniform must be worn in lessons taking place in classrooms.

### Compulsory:

- School blazer with school badge (worn at all times)
- White shirt (long or short sleeve, open neck, reverse collar and always tucked in)
- School kilt (4 inches below the knee)
- Tights (plain black, flesh or navy) or white socks
- Hair always tied back if longer than shoulder length
- Black polishable school shoes (not black trainers)

### Optional:

- Black or navy blue overcoat (worn outdoors only)
- Navy blue crested V-neck jumper
- One gold or silver stud in each ear lobe
- One thin necklace permitted (with small pendant but kept under the shirt)
- One thin bracelet on each wrist

### Not allowed:

- Rings
- Ankle bracelets
- Ear cuff/cartilage piercings
- Nose/lip/eyebrow piercings
- Nail varnish
- Make-up
- Hair that isn't a natural colour
- Extreme hairstyles
- Beads/threads in hair
- Fleece, sweatshirts and hoodies

# Looking your personal best

## Year 7 to 11 – Boys

All students should **arrive to school in full school uniform** and only wear sports kit when participating in sport or other outdoor activities that require it. School uniform must be worn in lessons taking place in classrooms.

### Compulsory:

- School blazer with school badge (worn at all times)
- White shirt (long sleeve, done up at the collar and always tucked in)
- House tie
- Dark grey (or charcoal) tailored trousers (no drain-pipes and must touch the shoes)
- Plain grey or black socks
- Black polishable school shoes (not black trainers)

### Optional:

- Black or navy blue overcoat (worn outdoors only)
- Navy blue crested V-neck jumper
- Plain black belt with a simple buckle

### Not allowed:

- Haircuts below a grade 2, visible shaved lines or exaggerated hairstyles (including mullets)
- Hair that isn't a natural colour
- Fleece, sweatshirts and hoodies
