

Mobile phones

We have a 'not seen, not heard' rule for mobile phones:

Prep School	Students must hand in their phone to their tutor during morning registration and collect at 17:20 (following clubs/activities/prep) or at 16:30 (if going home earlier).
Senior School: Year 9, 10, 11	Students must hand in their phone to their tutor during morning registration and collect at the end of afternoon registration at 16:30.
Sixth Form	Students can keep their phone about their person and will be permitted it within the Sixth Form Centre and/or their boarding study rooms only during the school day. They must follow the 'not seen, not heard' rule at all times around school.

If a phone is seen or heard during the school day outside of the designated areas, then it will be confiscated by staff and handed to Mrs Stubbington in an envelope (provided to staff).

Headphones are not allowed around the site (during the school day) or in lessons (including Prep) unless permission is granted by the teacher. Sixth Form students may wear headphones in the Sixth Form Centre or in the library.
