The Houseparent, or designated resident tutor, is responsible for the supervision of boarders in house and at breakfast.	The Tutor or Head of Year takes responsibility for the pupil once he/she has arrived at School, normally from 0815 onwards. The Prep School is supervised from 0800 onwards. Appropriate staffing is also deployed to the key drop off areas including the Johnson Centre carpark, Music carpark and coach park.	Sixth Form students will move to the Sixth Form Centre when they arrive at School

1800-1900 Supper and Free Time	Supper is supervised by boarding staff. Boarding Houses will be supervised by an appropriate member of the House team		
1900-2300	A member of the House team will be on duty, in the boarding house, registering students, keeping the house log book, overseeing bed times etc. Each house will have a signing out/in protocol post 1900, indicating where students will be. The Senior Deputy Head and Director of Boarding are resident on site.		
2300-0700	Boarders will be in the care, in loco parentis, of the House staff on site.
